Dues

The annual dues are **fifteen dollars (\$15.00)** for retired Xerox employees and **fifteen dollars (\$15.00)** for spouses. The program year runs January 1 to December 31. **Dues are not pro-rated**, and are used to defray administrative and operating costs as well as to reduce activity fees for participants.

Club Officers

The Pioneer Club is governed by an elected board of directors. Candidates are chosen by a nominating committee, as well as from membership nominations from the floor at the spring semi-annual business meeting. The club officers consist of: Chairperson; President; Vice President; Secretary(s); Treasurer; Program Chair and Member-at-Large. They are elected to office for a two-year term. The officers meet once a month except July, and are responsible for planning club programs and reviewing all recommended changes to the XRX Pioneer Club of Rochester's constitution and bylaws.

Sunshine News Chairperson

The sunshine chair sends cards to members who are ill, and sympathy cards to the family of deceased club members. Arrangements are also made by the chair for visits to shut-in members. **It is necessary that the members inform the chairperson so that cards may be sent. Pioneer Bowling League

Members of the XRX Pioneer Club of Rochester, Inc. bowling leagues meet each week at Empire Lanes or Bowl-A-Roll. The four-person teams bowl during the fall session (September through December), and the winter session (January through March) on Wednesdays at 9:30 a.m. You can bowl in either one or both sessions. There is a charge per week for three games of bowling and prize money. The season is culminated with an awards banquet at a local party house. Prizes are awarded to the first-place team. Awards are also given for high single game; high series; and other achievements.

Pioneer Golf League

New and existing golfers can take advantage of golf lessons that are offered each year to XRX Pioneer Golf League members offered by Webster Golf Club professionals at reduced rates.

There is a \$15 golf membership fee to join the XRX Pioneer Golf League, and green fees and cart fees per game (9 holes) are payable at the pro shop each week. The league culminates the season in late September with a tournament and awards banquet.

Membership

- Canceled checks will be the only receipt for clubmembership.

Luncheon Reservation Policy

- All Pioneer Club luncheon reservations must be made through the PIONEER CLUB ONLY. We cannot honor any others. **RESERVATIONS RECEIVED AFTER THE DEADLINE WILL BE RETURNED UNOPENED.**
- The **deadline for table reservations** for all Pioneer Club luncheons is one day after luncheon reservation deadline--regardless of the day of the week. Reservations are limited to those with at least four (4) and no more than eight (8) pertable.
- Reserved seating is only held until 15 minutes before the scheduled luncheon.

Luncheon Cancellation / Refund Policy

- If you are registered for a Pioneer Club luncheon and need to cancel for any reason, you must call the program chairperson **ONLY** at **(585) 545-4858**. The minimum length of time required to ensure a refund will vary upon the facility used. ***Check the registration form for each specific event's cut-off date.*** (Beyond that time, the Pioneer Club is committed to the banquet facility, with no refunds allowed.) Leave a message and include your name and phone number. **(NOTE: A handling fee of \$1.00 per person per cancellation will be deducted.)**

Trip and Travel

- Refunds for trips will be in accordance with the travel agency's policy. This will be stated in the trip brochure.
- Trips for the XRX Pioneer Club of Rochester, Inc. will be planned by the Trip and Travel Committee. Bids will be sought, and appropriate travel agencies will be selected by the committee based on total package, price and service.
- Travel agencies will provide all advertisement brochures, flyers and registration forms in time for *The Pioneer XPRESS* publication.
- All registrations, trip policies, communications, departure details and evaluations will be the responsibility of the travel agency.

GENERAL INFORMATION

Emergency procedures

Event Cancellation

In an unusual situation, the president, vice president and program chair, will make the decision to cancel an event. When and if a cancellation is deemed necessary, participants will be notified of such through a telephone tree. All table captains will be notified directly. It will be the responsibility of each table captain to notify those that request their table. All remaining participants who have no table captain indicated will be called directly.

Refunds will be made to members.

This procedure should allow for an effective and economical conclusion to any unforeseen change in plans.

Injury or Medical Emergency

In the case of severe injury or emergency medical trauma, always call 911 for assistance. An officer of the activity of the affected function or any Executive Board member should assume the responsibility of assuring that 911 is called.

Other 911 Calls

If anyone thinks there is a problem, please report it to a member of the Executive Board or the management of the facility where the problem exists. Members should not assume the responsibility of calling 911.

Death Benefits

Upon the death of any Xerox retiree who is covered by a Xerox-related life insurance policy, information can be obtained by calling 1-800-428-2203. This procedure requires the deceased member's Social Security Number. After calling the above number, enter the Social Security Number and, when asked for Pin Number, **press * 0**. Then wait until a person answers to relate your information.
